- Numbers Most professions have large numbers. CCMA Directory list 235 +/-Cadastral/GIS type positions in 58 counties, of which 24 counties list only 1.
- Approach Best to start by making the Certification Optional.

No Test!

- Point-based and self-documented
- Based on achievement in 3 categories:
 - Education attainment
 - Professional experience
 - Contributions to the profession

CERTIFICATION LEVELS

Cadastral Analyst

This would be the general category. Cadastral work at the journeyman level.

Cadastral/GIS Analyst

This would be the general category with heavy background/experience with GIS in cadastral work. Also, cadastral/GIS work at the journeyman level.


CERTIFICATION LEVELS

Master Cadastral Analyst

This would be the advanced category. More experience and education then the Cadastral Analyst or Cadastral/GIS Analyst.

This level is for the most experienced and those making final decisions as they relate to cadastral mapping.

Minimum Qualifications Classifications Total Pts. **Experience** Cadastral 150 4 Yrs. Analyst Cadastral/GIS 150 🖈 4 Yrs. Analyst Min. 50 Pts. from GIS related Courses, Experience, or Contributions. Master Cadastral 6 Yrs.☆ 200 Analyst Min. 2 years decision making/supervisory exp.



Point EXAMPLES - Professional Experience

Job Experience is the most IMPORTANT Factor in Cadastral Qualifications

Decision Making / SupervisoryExperience35 pts

 Cadastral or Cadastral/GIS work at the Journeyman Level 25 pts

Classroom Instructor/Teacher 15 pts

- *7 Members Appointed for 2 Year Terms.
 Their terms would stagger.
- Must be Master Analyst.
- **Responsible for All Records and Application Processing.

Grandfathering Provision

> Cadastral Analyst

200 Points 5 or More Yrs. Any Category

➤ Cadastral/GIS Analyst

200 Points 5 or More Yrs. Any Category Min. 85 pts. from GIS related courses, exp., etc.

➤ Master Cadastral Analyst

300 points 8 or More Yrs. Any Category Min. 3 years decision making/supervisory exp.

How will the Processing Work?



Applying for Certification

- > Applications are sent in for certification.
- > Reviewed by Certification Committee.
- > Application is ACCEPTED or REJECTED.
- > Certificate and letter sent

OR

Rejection letter explaining why.

Renewal of Certification

Cadastral Professionals must maintain currency with the profession.

- Need to Renew every 5 Years.
- Cycle begins with Certification date.
- Minimum Points Required:

Experience 50
Education 4
Contributions 5
Additional (Any) 11
TOTAL: 70
